Ukraine Backpacks

Last Christmas, Yulia and her husband Nick traveled to Ukraine to deliver over 400 Christmas gifts packed and wrapped by Stanwood Foursquare. As they were driving to a local village, they saw a young boy standing on the side of the road next to his home which had been severely damaged by the war.

Nick and Yulia offered him a Christmas gift and his face lit up with so much joy! He then told Yulia that he had a brother and that his father was a soldier fighting on the front lines. Yulia, Nick and her father prayed

with the boy sharing the hope and love of Jesus.

Ukraine Outreach



Over the last two years, Ukraine has been devastated by the ongoing war. Many people have lost their homes, their livelihood, and many children are mourning the loss of their fathers and family members. Stanwood Foursquare has had the joy of partnering with *United to Help* in Ukraine to send over 30 tons of humanitarian aid and Christmas gifts for children.

Next summer, 2024, Stanwood Foursquare is sending a team to help serve alongside *United to Help*, to bring encouragement, distribute aid and share the hope of Jesus. We will be helping to facilitate a summer camp for children, offering a week of fun along with opportunities to learn English, a necessity for future economic success. We will also rebuild a playground destroyed by the war.






O Come, O Come Emmanuel

Clean Water Namibia, Africa



On the northern side of the desert in Namibia, Caspir Amukoshi is the pastor of the local Foursquare church, sharing the hope of Jesus with the people of this dry desert country. Clean water is almost impossible to find and families have to walk over 5 miles to source water that is dirty and full of harmful bacteria.

Partnering with Foursquare Disaster Relief, and local churches, your gift towards water filtration buckets and wells, will allow the people of Northern Namibia to access clean water and hear the Good News of Jesus.

Malaria is a constant concern for the people of Burundi. Fortunately, malaria and other local illnesses can be effectively treated with simple interventions, providing much-needed relief.



Livestock Morocco



In early September 2023, a deadly 6.8 magnitude earthquake hit the isolated Atlas Mountains in Morocco. Hundreds of thousands of survivors have lost everything and some remote villages in the mountains remain without aid, food and supplies. Families lost farms and livestock, their sole source of food and income.

Partnering with Foursquare Disaster Relief (FDR), we are able to provide the necessary livestock and share the message of Jesus with those recovering from this disaster, giving them the hope of a better life with long-term access to income and nourishment.

Think Small Nepal



In May, 2023, *Think Small* partnered with a local church in Nepal to host an outreach for children to train them to resist human trafficking and abuse, a devestating reality in this country. The only time these children were able to come was at dawn, before school began. Over 40 children walked for 3 miles in the dark to reach the church before sunrise. When they arrived, local leaders shared with them their value, how God sees them and loves them, and trained them in how to resist human trafficking. At the end of the event, all 40 children said "YES" to Jesus and returned the next week to learn to be disciples of Jesus.

Through Stanwood Church's partnership with *Think Small*, last year over 3500 children received Jesus, entered discipleship and were trained to prevent trafficking, abuse and drugs.



Taste of Home Chocolate Cake Recipe

2/3 cup butter, softened

1 2/3 cups sugar

3 large eggs

2 cups flour

2/3 baking cocoa

1 1/4 tsp baking soda

1 tsp salt

1 1/3 cup milk

In a bowl, cream butter and sugar until fluffy. Add eggs one at a time beating well after each addition. Combine flour, cocoa, baking soda and salt; add to creamed mixture alternately with milk, beating until smooth after each addition. Pour batter into a greased and floured 13"x 9" pan. Bake at 350° for 35-40 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean. Cool and serve with favorite frosting.

Merval, a young pastor and trained barber who is part of the Crow Nation, recently planted a church in the town of Lodge Grass on the Crow Reservation in Montana. Several years ago, Stanwood Foursquare partnered with *Arise Native Americans* to help build a building in Lodge Grass that now serves both as a gathering place for the church and a barbershop! Merval is able to use his skills cutting hair to support his young family while pastoring this community.

Arise Native American Ministry organizes camps for families to offer a week of rest, equipping, training, fun and encouragement for leaders like Merval, doing Kingdom work in Native communities all over North America.
